ABOUT FARF—A SMALL INITIATIVE


Fundamental Action and Research Foundation (FARF)** is a Bengaluru based non-profit organization, working in the field of Rural development, agriculture and related research areas. FARF’s primary focus has been on rural and agricultural development, helping people from rural and remote places so that they are not left behind from rest of the country in the fast moving world of Information Technology.

In order to help in agriculture and rural development, it is working towards transparency in Government schemes, awareness campaigns, agriculture campaigns among other things.

As part of its rural development program, FARF has started unique initiative in 2016 called **FARF Adarsh Gram Yojana (FAGY)** by adopting 5 villages. In FAGY initiative, FARF has planned to spread awareness about central & state Government schemes, allocated village level budgets and expenses, technical and legal advises on these 5 selected villages.

At the same time, it has planned to continue awareness campaign and rural development workshop. FARF has initiated a five-day rural engagement program ‘KALRAV’ in villages of Bhadohi (near Varanasi), Uttar Pradesh . The goal of this program is to bridge gap between rural and Urban India and bring meaningful change in

OUR JOURNEY SO FAR

- ⇒ FARF has adopted 7 villages (Sanathpur, Bhikharirampur, Naiyapur, Ahmadpur Phulwariya, Raipur, Shikhapur, Jorai) in Bhadohi constituency.
- ⇒ During 2017 UP State elections, FARF conducted interviews of contestants discussing their manifestos and help voters understanding their representatives views.
- ⇒ FARF has collaborated with similar organizations and involving experts from universities locally and internationally.
- ⇒ We have initiated new program to support child education, received good response from India and outside.
- ⇒ Provided consultancy related to rural development on need basis to numerous individuals and filed numerous RTIs related to rural development, central government schemes and Agricultural info.
- ⇒ Started program 'Kalrav' to connect rural and modern India. Kalrav is a five day rural engagement program organizing in Bhadohi, Uttar Pradesh. It's aim is to encourage people to connect with village life and try to understand its nuances.
- ⇒ We started digital service, where we are providing online details related to various schemes.

MEET OUR PEOPLE



IMPORTANT INFORMATION RELATED TO AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT

- ⇒ In the Union budget, the total allocation for rural, agricultural and allied sectors for 2017-18 is Rs 187223 crore, which is 24% higher than last year's .
- ⇒ The target for agriculture credit is fixed at Rs 10 lakh crore.
- ⇒ Target for agricultural credit in 2017-18 fixed at Rs 10 lakh per person.
- ⇒ The government will issue soil health cards and will setup a mini lab in Krishi Vigyan Kendras.
- ⇒ Fasal Bima Yojana will be increased to 40 percent from 30 percent .
- ⇒ A dedicated micro-irrigation fund will be set up by NABARD to achieve the goal of 'Per Drop More Crop'. Its initial corpus will be Rs 5000 crore .
- ⇒ Dairy processing infrastructure fund will be set up under NABARD, with fund of 8,000 crore
- ⇒ Allocation for rural sector for Fiscal Year 2018 is Rs 1,87,200 cr, which is a record, and represents an increase of 24%.
- ⇒ Allocation under MNREGA increased from Rs 38,500 crore to Rs 48,000 crore.
- ⇒ 100% village electrification will be achieved by May 1,2018.
- ⇒ 1,00,00,000 houses by 2019 for houseless and those living in kaccha houses.
- ⇒ Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana+ allocation raised from Rs 15,000 crore to Rs 23,000 crore.
- ⇒ Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojna roads work accelerated to 133 km roads per day in 2016-17 against 73 km per day during 2011-14.


